## PROTOCOLS and GUIDELINES for Covid 19



As previously mentioned we will be returning to **full in-person learning** this fall. **Virtual learning will only be offered out of necessity, not convenience.** That being said, we continue to get information from the PA Department of Health as well as the Archdiocese as to what it will look like in our schools this upcoming year. It is a fluid situation that will continue to change as the month of August passes by. Our SMM COVID Task Force has met and developed a plan for our school, awaiting approval.

The Archdiocese of Philadelphia will also be issuing its recommendations and guidelines this coming week. They too are awaiting approval from the Archbishop and necessary legal parties.

It is our hope to send you these documents as soon as they are available. As we reflect back on all the mitigations, restrictions and procedures from last year, we feel that much was learned and we hope this coming year will be and look much different as we move toward a more normal environment, but still focused on what is best for the well-being and health of the **entire school community**.

It should be noted that the wearing of masks **WILL BE** part of our mitigation efforts this upcoming school year. We have all intentions of remaining open for the 2021-2022 school year and the wearing of masks will help us in seeing that through. We are excited to get back to some normalcy in the building.

## NEW LUNCH PROGRAM AT SMM

- ✚ The lunch program will **start** on **Monday, September 27, 2021**.
- ✚ The SMM **menu** will be available on **September 23, 2021**.
- ✚ We will be making lunches available Monday through Thursday.
- ✚ You will be able to order by the week, month or longer.
- ✚ Orders **MUST** be placed by **midnight the Saturday before the week starts**. (Saturday, Sept. 25<sup>th</sup>)
- ✚ **Orders can NOT be placed once the week opens, however, if your child(ren) is/are absent, you will be able to cancel their lunch by 9:00am and not be charged for it.**

We have hired a point person to organize the delivery of the Yay Lunches each day. Two of our parents have offered to volunteer to assist her on two of the days (Mondays and Wednesdays). It would be great if we could have two other parents volunteer for Tuesday or Thursday. Contact Ms. Winterberger if interested. This would cover your recess duty obligation.
