TRANSITIONS

We are very happy to announce that we will be restoring to some of our traditions starting on Monday, May 2, 2022.

- ➤ Morning Prayer is returning to the gym. The students in grades K-8 will assembly in the gym for morning prayer, pledges and announcements each morning at 8:00am.
 - o All K-8 students will enter the building through the back gym doors.
 - o PreK students will go directly into the building as they normally do.
 - It is essential that every student is on time for school. They should be in the building before 8:00am.
- > Use of the Cafeteria will be increased.
 - o Grades 4/5, 1/3, and 7/8 will be in the cafeteria every other day for lunch.
 - We will increase the table capacity from 3 to a table to 6 to a table.
 - o Grades K, 2 and 6 will continue as a single grade in the cafeteria on the other day due to the number of students in those grades.
 - o In September our hope is to return all three grades to the cafeteria for lunch. Due to the increase in enrollment, the Home & School has purchased 3 additional tables for the cafeteria.
 - Our goal is to then have 8 students per table.
