PreK – 5 Truck or Treat ~ **closes October 20th**




❖ October Stewardship Activities

- Teachers will reference the Progress Report at Parent Conferences




- Please note the change in the process for determining the grade for the Effort and Study Skills and the Personal and Social Growth grades for students in grades 4 to 8.

All the Archdiocesan Catholic Elementary School are Accredited every seven years by the Middle States Association. St. Mary Magdalen’s Accreditation expires in May of 2022. Due to all the COVID restrictions during the 2020-2021 school year, we requested and were granted an extension to do our self-study and seek our accreditation for the 2022-2023 school year.

This year’s In-Services and Faculty Meetings have been dedicated to writing our self-study and determining the direction of school improvement for the next seven years. The self-study is based on input from all our stakeholders, including our parents, students, teachers, staff, Home & School Association and our School Board.

Data is gathered through surveys (developed by the Middle States Association) to then be analyzed to formulate goals for the school.
